ORDER

1. The appeal No. 21/2021 has been filed by Shri Jargam Ali and Others through their advocate Shri Nishikant Ray against the order of the Forum (CGRF-BYPL) dated 17.06.2021 passed in Complaint No. 29/2021. The basic issue concerned in the Appellant's grievance is regarding the non-release of new electricity connections by the Discom (Respondent) in their flat/property bearing No. 2207, Third Floor, Left and Right Side, Mohalla Road Gram, Lal Kuan, Near Main Road, Delhi - 110006.


2. The Appellant approached the CGRF, wherein the CGRF decided the case with the directions as under:

"In the absence of the clear architect map and taking cognizance of the affidavit filed by the Respondent, we are of the considered opinion:

- i. That in the present scenario, this Forum is not in a position to give any relief to the complainant.*
- ii. That this Forum directs the Respondent that if in future the complainant approach with the clear architect map showing complete details of the each dwelling unit on the third floor of*

the premises, the Respondent should release the new connections as per DERC Regulations."

3. As the Appellant was not satisfied with the order of the CGRF, hence, he preferred this appeal against the order dated 17.06.2021. The Discom submitted their reply wherein they conveyed that the new electricity connections cannot be released as the Appellant has not been able to fulfill the directions given by the CGRF and the entire third floor is duly electrified by way of four electricity connections, as such no new electricity connections can be granted.
4. The case was under process for fixing up the date of hearing but in the meantime a communication dated 10.09.2021 was received from the Advocate of the Appellant vide which the Appellant has requested that he does not want to further pursue/contest the above said appeal and his request for withdrawal of the appeal may be accepted. The request application of the Appellant for withdrawal of the appeal has also been signed by all the four Appellants.
5. In view of above, the case is accordingly disposed of as withdrawn.
